

Anneville Local Recommendations Handout

Parking:

Parking at Liberty Station is free. Most times of the day you'll find spaces available in the lot in front of Barracks 15 or across the street in the Ace lot. Another option is the lot behind Barracks 3 and 4 which you can enter from Truxton Rd.

Best ways to come and go when driving:

Our rush hour times can start as early as 3pm due to nearby military and school traffic. Avoid Sims Road, the one-way road that goes alongside the Public Market - it is very congested most of the time. Exiting via Rosecrans is always fastest.

Eats:

Quick coffee, lunch and pastries: Chi Chocolat.
Good sandwiches, cookies & coffee (but slowww service: Con Pane

Lunch:

Best prices (and a little exercise!): Trader Joe's or Von's (ready-to-eat salads, sandwiches and fresh fruit and more).

Best variety: Liberty Public Market (salads, tacos, lobster rolls, cepes, empanadas, full bakery, more but a bit pricey).

Dinner:

Healthy cafeteria-style option (but pricey): Tender Greens.

Best variety: Liberty Public Market.

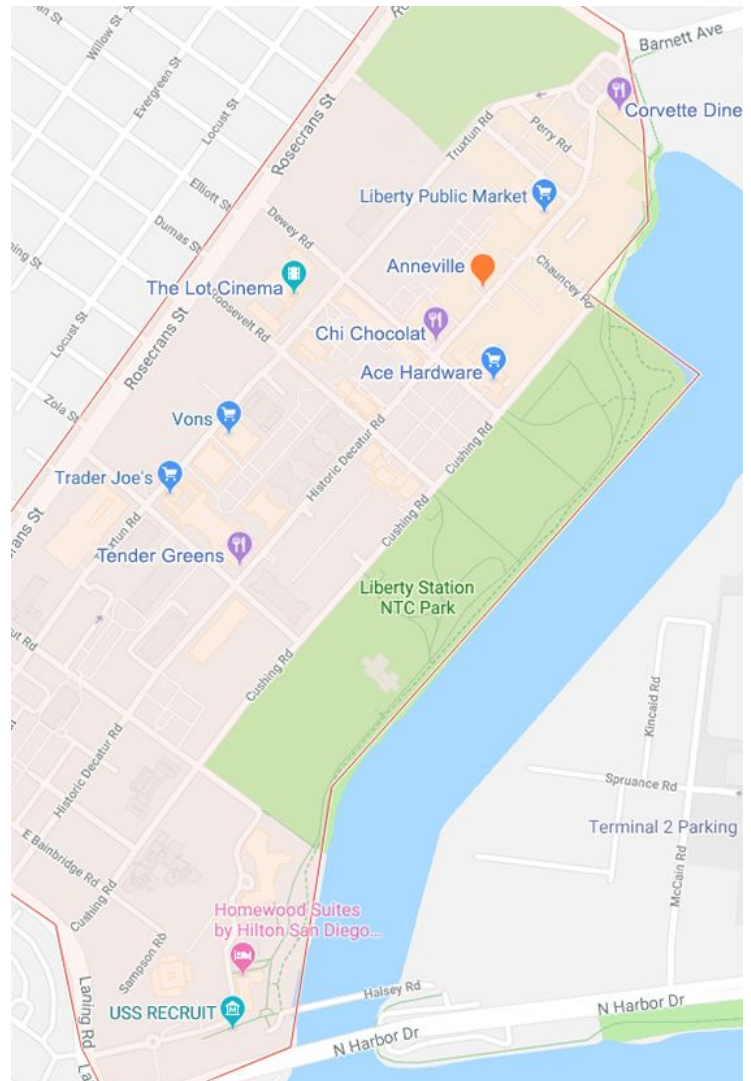
Table service/outdoor: Fireside, Stone Brewery
